WEATHER INTERROGATION SUMMARY FOR MISSION OF 19 JUNE 1944

TAKE-OFF: 0500. 10/10 stratocumulus, base 1000', tops 1500'. Nil middle or high cloud. Visibility 6 miles.

ROUTE OUT: 10/10 stratocumulus, tops 1500' to 2000', breaking to 6-8/10 at London, becoming 8-10/10 at mid-channel, becoming 10/10 cumulus at about 49 degrees N, 1 degree W, tops building to 21-25,000' at 47 deg. 50 min. N, 1 deg. W, breaking to 6-8/10 at about 47 deg. 30 min. N, 1 deg. W, tops decreasing to 15-18,000', further decreasing to 0-3/10 cumulus, tops 12-15,000' in the target area. Nil middle or high cloud reported. Visibility unrestricted aloft.

TARGET: 0928. 0-3/10 cumulus, tops 12-15,000'. Nil middle or high cloud. Visibility unrestricted.

ROUTE BACK: Similar to route out over the continent and channel, except tops building to 30-31,000' in the frontal zone. Low cloud breaking to 2-4/10 over Southern England and increasing to 7-9/10 cumulus and stratocumulus, base 1500', tops 2-3000' in base area. Visibility unrestricted aloft.

BASE ON RETURN: 1158. 8/10 cumulus, base 1500', tops 2-3000'. Visibility 7 miles.

REMARKS: Light to moderate non-persistent contrails at 18-25,000', becoming dense persistent at 25-31,000'. Temperatures were 3-4 deg. colder than forecast between 25,000' and 30,000'; -32 deg. at 25,000', -40 deg. at 29,500'. Winds aloft: 50-60 deg. at 26 knots at 16-17,000' over England; 105 deg. at 24 knots at 20,000' over the channel; 108 deg. at 30 knots at 26,000' over northern France; 305 deg. at 42 knots at 26,000' in the target area.
